#### **LATE BOOK**

### Beginning Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September

As previously notified the school will be introducing a late book from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> September. This enables the school to monitor lateness and the possible impact on a child's attainment. As soon as the children have entered the building the school doors are locked. After 8:55am a child is late. The late book will need to be completed with a reason for the lateness.

We can all have times when we are late now and again. For those families it is not a regular occasion and the school is aware of that. The late book enables the school to monitor which families are consistently late, which is disruptive for the class which are already settled and is often embarrassing for the child themselves.

#### After School Football

As you are aware the regular football coach is unable to commit this term to football training. The school have been in discussions with the Strachem Foundation, who are happy to lead a football club during the Autumn term. To enable the club to start as soon as possible, I will need to know how many children wish to participate so that the appropriate number of coaches can be booked.
