

Road Cycle Safety Event Opportunity

The school was offered the opportunity to take part in a project run by a team from CEMEX which is aimed at teaching primary school children about the dangers of large goods vehicles.

The children were given a presentation which lasted around 30 minutes and covered topics such as: general road safety, cycling safety and having the correct safety equipment.

As part of the session they also brought one of their vehicles which the children looked around; sat in the cabin; walked around the vehicle to give them an appreciation of its size and blind spots and potential dangers. One child stood in front of the stationary lorry and waved, the children were surprised at how far away from the lorry they had to be for the driver to see them.

This project was offered free to the school and it is hoped it will have a positive impact on the children in keeping themselves and others safe.
