Where do our ingredients come from?

All our menus meet the Government's School Food Standards which came into force on 1st January 2015.

Meat

Minced beef and beef grills are organic and farm assured from Lower Hurst Organic Farm in Derbyshire.

Pork is farm assured and RSPCA Freedom Foods accredited from UK Foodhall and our **organic pork meatballs** from Norfolk are supplied by Green Gourmet.

Poultry comes from a variety of suppliers and is all British, farm assured Red Tractor accredited.

Our gold medal winning **sausages** are made from farm assured pork by Langford's butchers of Welshpool.

Eggs

The eggs we use in our own recipe dishes are all free range and come from farms in Leicestershire. We are the proud recipients of a Good Egg Award, which celebrates companies who are using only cage-free eggs or egg products.

Fish

We seek to use fully sustainable and traceable fish. Certified sustainable seafood is labelled (MSC) on our menus, our salmon fillet fingers are also gluten free.

Fruit and Vegetables

We source most of our fruit and vegetables from the UK and our local region (Worcestershire, Staffordshire and Leicestershire) to minimise fuel emissions from long-haul transportation and help support UK producers.

Baked Beans are from the UK and are a low salt/sugar variety.

Potatoes, Breads and Crackers

These products are sourced from within the UK.

Yoghurts

Come from the Muller Dairy in Shropshire.

Biscuits

All our biscuits are homemade to our own special recipes.

We use recognised brands where possible, these include;
McCain, Muller, Jacobs, Dr Oetker, Knorr, Bird's Eye, Branston, Quorn and Ambrosia

The sugar and drinking chocolate we use is Fair Trade.
We offer **organic semi skimmed milk** from British dairy farms, to drink at lunchtime, alongside chilled water and Aqua Juice fruit cordial.
